

2026 National Oxford On-Line Sale

Tuesday, June 2, 2026; 12:00 noon to 8:00 PM (Eastern Time)

Breeders' World On-Line Platform

Deadlines: May 19, 2026 – Notify AOSA Office of plans to consign – must have at least 10 head or sale will be cancelled.

May 26, 2026 – Entries must be in to Breeders' World (including photos/videos) – must have at least 10 head or sale will be cancelled.

Fees: No Entry Fee; 10% Commission Fee; \$25/head No-Sale Fee; \$25/head Buy-Back Fee up to \$1,000 bid; 10% per head Buy-Back Fee if bid is over \$1,000.

Requirements:

- All rams entered in the National Oxford On-Line Sale must have a negative test for Spider Syndrome and test results must be listed in the on-line description for the animal. It is strongly recommended that all ewes also have DNA test results listed in the animal description.
- Consignors must be current AOSA members.
- Consignors will set their own floor price on each animal they consign.
- Females (yearling ewes and ewe lambs) may be nominated for the respective Futurity program by consignors prior to June 2, 2026 (*Futurity rules and forms are available at the AOSA website*).
- Ownership date on transfers will be the date "good" payment is received from the buyer.
- Consignors will pay the appropriate transfer fees via settlement deduction.
- Delivery of animals will be coordinated between the consignor and the buyer at the buyer's expense unless other arrangements are agreed upon prior to the sale.
- In addition to a written description of each animal consigned, the consignor is also responsible for providing individual photographs and/or videos of their consigned animals. **These photographs/videos are due to Breeders' World no later than May 26, 2026.**
- Entry forms that list "*information later*" or similar wording will be considered incomplete entries and will not be accepted.
- Written descriptions shall be limited to 30 words or less per animal.
- **By making entries in the National Oxford On-Line Sale, the consignor agrees to the above requirements and to the Terms & Conditions for the National Oxford Show and Sale which can be found at the AOSA website.**
